- Able to process information gathered and communicate the results for different audiences on various online platforms.
- Able to use basic IT packages including research software or programmes and social / digital media.

Volunteers in the business development team will ideally be:

- Passionate about social enterprise with some knowledge of business planning.
- Interested in, with some basic knowledge of, research skills relevant to business and enterprise or materials and products.
- Creative in solving problems and producing solutions.
- Able to use basic administration, social / digital media, and IT skills.

Volunteers interested in environmental sustainability will ideally be:

- Enthusiastic about supporting organisations to improve environmental sustainability.
- Interested in, with some knowledge of, sustainable practices relevant to Azizi Life's work for example materials / business processes / production techniques / carbon footprint.
